

Maths:

We will be continuing to develop our multiplication and division skills to recall number facts and solve problems. We will be using our mathematical skills to understand and develop our reasoning in support of our answers.

We will then be exploring area and measurements of rectilinear shapes. We will also be learning to recognise and solve problems involving fractions and decimals.

English:

In English this term we will focus on:

- Non-chronological reports about a place to create a Guide to Hull.
- A newspaper report to detail a historic Hull event. (renewable energy)
- A fictional narrative to tell a magical tale.
- Exploring form through performance poetry. (culture poem?)

French:

In French this term we will be reviewing all that we have learn so far and will be extending this to learn words and phrases linked to the new topic 'The Carnival of the animals'.

Music:

Year 4 will continue to have their music lessons with Mr King on a Monday afternoon. We will continue to develop our musical performance skills.

Theme:

During this term, the children in Year 4 will be focussing on 'Hull's Heroes'. We will be learning about ambassadors of Hull and how they have influenced Hull today. This will link to our work completed within both **History** and **Geography** lessons too. It will allow us to explore our theme in more depth.

History and Geography:

In History this term we will be becoming historians to research and find out answers to questions about our local area.

In Geography we will be learning about the human and physical characters of Hull and how these have changed over time.

We will be focussing on Electricity this term in Science. We will be identifying electrical and non-electrical appliances used within everyday life. We will then be investigating how electrical circuits work and the children will have the opportunity to create a circuit of their own.

Computing:

In Computing, the children will be focussing on computer science. We will be experimenting with variables and control models to write programs that control technology.

RE:

Our RE Unit for this term will be Saints and Heroes. We will be exploring the key question: What makes a hero? We will learn about past and present saints and heroes from different world faiths.

PE:

The children will be learning how to perform a variety of movements in gymnastics and will be developing their team work skills through taking part in a variety of different invasion games.

The children will also be exploring movement and shape in dance sessions, whilst also developing their cricket skills during outdoor sessions.

Art and DT:

In Art we will be learning about a famous Hull artist. We will be given the opportunity to appraise and comment on their artwork before using their work as inspiration to create our own. We will be focussing on the use of oil painting to explore different painting techniques. In DT we will be learning about cooking and nutrition, linked to food in Hull.

PSHE:

This term we will continue to follow our PSHE Jigsaw scheme to focus upon our dreams and goals. We will then be learning about healthy lifestyles to review the importance of keeping fit, active and healthy. We will also continue to explore and develop different mindfulness techniques and activities.
