


Make your own Chinese Dragon

1) Cut out the dragon's head from a small

piece of coloured card.




2) Cut a rectangle from a piece of different coloured card. Cut wavy lines along the card to make the dragon's beard. Glue this onto the back of the dragon's head.






3) Cut out some teeth from white paper and stick them above the beard. Cut out two eye shapes and glue onto the face. Cut out some shapes from different coloured card to decorate the head. Add sequins for the eyes and nose.





4) Glue two long strips of red and yellow paper together at right angles. Make a concertina body by folding the bottom strip over the top strip repeatedly. Make sure you glue the ends together securely.





5) Cut some narrow strips out of different coloured paper for the tail. Curl them carefully using your thumb and some scissors.

Glue these to the end of the dragons body.
