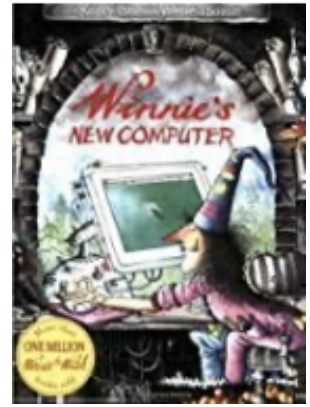



Pack 10 Guided Reading: "Winnie's New Computer"

These activities are planned to improve a child's comprehension/ understanding of a text.

Some children will need support when reading this text; if your child is finding any of these activities difficult - don't worry!



Day	Suggested Activity
Monday	<p>Summary: What has happened in 'Winnie's New Computer' so far?</p> <p>Inference: Read up to page 19 together. How do you think Winnie is feeling?</p> <p>Challenge: Can you tell me using evidence from the text?</p> <p>Parents- inference can be tricky for children as they have to 'read between the lines' and cannot just retrieve the answer from the text.</p> 
Tuesday	<p>Re-read pages 15-18 and answer the questions below. You can either write the answers in your book or answer them verbally with a grown-up.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. What did Winnie make for Wilbur when she woke up? 2. List three places that Winnie looked for Wilbur. 3. Where did Winnie find Wilbur? 4. Fill in the missing words in these sentences: Winnie could not find Wilbur or her _____. Winnie reached into the cupboard for her book of _____. Winnie shouted "_____!" but it was too late.
Wednesday	<p>Read to the end of the story together. Now you've finished the story, I would like you to discuss the significance of the title:</p> <p>Why do you think the title is important? What does it tell you?</p>
Thursday	<p>Description: Write a description for Wilbur the cat. Can you use lots of adjectives to describe him?</p> <p>Can you then draw a picture to match your description?</p>
Friday	<p>Review: Can you tell me a part of the story you liked and a part you did not like.</p>
