Covid-19 update

As you will all be aware the government recently announced how different areas around the country will move into different alert levels depending on the number of Covid-19 cases in that area. Currently we are at the medium level. However, over recent weeks, cases have significantly increased so there is a possibility that we could move into the high level at some point. As soon as we know any further information we will inform you. Schools will continue to be open if we move into the high level.

If your child or anyone in your family develops symptoms and tests positive for Covid-19 over the half term holiday please can you contact the school so that we can monitor this?

It is very important that we gather this information so that we can keep a record of any positive cases and about who is isolating because this could mean that we would need to contact parents of other pupils in your child's class bubble.

So far attendance in school is **95.1%** so we are still trying to achieve our whole school target of 96%,

Parent/Carers' Evening

Thank you to all parents and carers for attending your appointment with your child's class teacher. The teachers have been really pleased with the positive comments they have received and about how parents have engaged with the school. If you have not yet been in contact with your child's teacher, please contact the school to arrange an appointment.

<u>Uniform</u> It's great to see all the children looking smart in their school uniform. Please remember that tracksuit bottoms are not school uniform. All pupils should be wearing trousers or skirts/dresses.

Also, <u>sandshoes</u> are also part of our school uniform and must be worn inside. Please make sure your child has a pair of sandshoes at school. This is for health and safety reasons and helps to keep the floors clean and dry, particularly now that the weather is turning. This is very important now that we are approaching the winter weather.

Please also remember that we are keeping rooms well-ventilated so all pupils need jumpers or cardigans in school.

PE kits must be worn for PE lessons. Pupils will need to have an indoor and an outdoor PE kit. We are trying to do most of our PE outside and as the weather is changing pupils will need jogging bottoms, a sweatshirt and trainers. If you are not sure about when PE kit is needed please contact the school by telephone.

Uniform can be ordered online or by telephoning the school office. Once orders have been placed and payment has been received, uniform will be given to children in school. If you need any support with purchasing uniform, please contact the school office in confidence.
