Do you think you would be scared if you found a bear? Would you run back home and hide like they did?
Additional Activities	The family and the bear left footprints along the beach. Paint your feet and walk across a big piece of paper, what do you notice about the marks that you leave behind. Can you create a pattern with them?	Use toilet rolls and string to create a pair of binoculars. These are brilliant for finding bears and you can decorate them however you like. You could make a list of all of the things that you find with them.	The grass in the story is 'long, wavy grass'. Find some things in your house or garden that are long or short. You can write or draw them in the table on the next page.	Draw or paint a picture of the bear. Will he be a big tall bear or a short fluffy bear? Don't forget to share your picture with us on tapestry.	The bear in the story lives in a 'narrow, gloomy cave'. Use materials and things from around your house to create a den. Perhaps you will read or draw inside your den, you could use torches to create shadow puppets or take in turns to use with someone else in your house.
