Science

We will also use our observation skills and observe and measure how tall plants grow over a period of time.

Maths

We will be exploring fractions. We will focus on identifying a half and a quarter of objects, shapes and quantities. We will also focus on time and recognising o'clock and half past on a clock. Throughout this half term we will also consolidate our knowledge of place value to 100.
