

History

In History we will be learning about medieval castles. We will explore why they were built and their different features. We will also learn about Queen Elizabeth 1, Victoria and Elizabeth 2 and compare them. We will also be discussing the upcoming Jubilee.

Geography

In Geography we will learn about different castles and their locations within the United Kingdom. We will look at why castles have been built in particular locations and discuss their physical features

Art and D.T.

In art we will explore the works of Picasso. We will develop our sketching techniques and create our own self portraits in the style of Picasso, In D.T. we will be constructing our own castle structures. We will think about hinge mechanisms and how they work.

R.E.

In R,E we will focus on the idea of creation We will compare the Christian and Muslim versions of the creation story and how the world began.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be focusing on positive relationships and what a positive relationship looks like. We will also look at our bodies and the differences between males and females.

Writing

In writing we will be exploring the texts of The Egg by MP Robertson and The Queens Knickers by Nicholas Allan. We will be focusing on writing different text types such as recounts, instructions and poetry.

Maths

In maths we will be working on fractions. We will learn how to work out a half and quarter of a quantity. We will also learn about multiplication and division. We will finally learn to tell the time to the hour and half an hour. We will also have a strong focus on place value to 100.

Science

In science we will focus on identifying different types of plants . We will observe how they flower at different types of the year and compare their similarities and differences. We will also learn about the basic structure of a plant.

In PE we will be developing our fitness and athletic techniques and skills in preparation for Sports Day.
