

D.T/Art

Children will learn about mechanics and making moving story books. In Art we will focus on the artist Cezanne and his famous landscapes.

Writing

In Writing, our model text is 'The Magic Shell'. We will be writing our own wishing tale and innovating the character. Our main focus will be on basic skills and ensuring we are working hard on our transcription and composition especially our handwriting.

We will continue with our daily RWI phonics lessons, improving our reading fluency skills.

Computing

In computing, we will be learning about algorithms and using robots to help us with our learning.

Maths

In maths we are learning to add and subtract across a ten and what it means to exchange. We will also be looking at and exploring money, shape, length and height as well as mass. We will develop our mathematical understanding through a variety of practical activities as well as fluency, reasoning and problem solving.

Theme

This term we will be diving into the depths of the world's oceans as we learn geographical features of the world. Our journey will take us to Antarctica, where we will compare the landscape to where we live. We will also look at the Arctic and compare both of these vast landscapes. We look at different habitats, sea life and animals along the way. We will compare these and consider what different animals need to survive.

P.E.

In PE, we will be developing our dance and gymnastic skills. We are focusing on the key concepts movement and agility to create sequences to music.

Science

In Science we are looking at living things and their habitats. We will learn about animal habitats, food chains and compare the similarities and differences of these animals. We will also consider different animal habitats across the world. We will also be learning about staying healthy as humans.

Geography

In Geography, we will be using maps and compass points to identify the 7 continents of the world, their oceans, the equator and the poles. Our main focus is Oceans and the Arctic and looking at different ecosystems.

Music

In music we will be thinking about how music teaches us about our neighbourhood. We will learn the difference between a rhythm pattern and pitch pattern. We will see how the speed of the beat can change, creating a faster or slower pace (tempo). We will work to create our own personal musical ideas using the skills we learn throughout this unit and perform our creations to others.

R.E.

In R.E, we will study the unit 'Believing'. We will discuss how people demonstrate their beliefs. We will be learning about what different people believe in and how these beliefs are expressed differently through different religions.
