

### History

In history, we will be looking at WW2, why it started, who it involved, the Blitz and its impact on Hull. We will learn about the Battle of Britain and how strategies and technology developed over this period of history. We will then explore various safety measures, including evacuation, before looking at rationing.

### English

In English, we start the term focusing on short narratives, including dialogue to convey character and advance the action. We will compose balanced arguments on whether evacuation should have happened or not. We will continue to work on our handwriting and transcription skills.

In guided reading, we will be reading 'When the Sky Falls' by Phil Earle, a local author, and 'Once' by Morris Gleitzman. We will continue to read a variety of related texts and video clips in our daily guided reading lessons.

### Maths

In maths we will be continuing to consolidate our place value knowledge and four operations as well as recapping shape, measure and statistics.

We will end the summer term with various maths projects applying our knowledge.

### R.E.

In R.E, we will focus on hopes and visions for ourselves and the world considering the purpose of life and different faith views on this question.

## Year 6 Summer Term: Bullets, Bombs and Blitz

### Art and DT

In art, children will learn about Roy Lichtenstein and his artistic style and techniques before replicating and practising their Ben-Day dots before designing and creating their own Lichtenstein-inspired pop art.

Our DT project will be appraising, designing and creating bomb shelters, building upon knowledge from our history unit. We will focus on the key concept of structure to ensure our shelters are strong!

### Music

We will continue to access session from Hull Music Service and developing our composition and performance skills.

### P.E.

In PE, we will be looking at football and rounders. The class will continue to develop leadership skills, leading warm-up exercises, critiquing their own performances and evaluating others'.

### Science

In science, we will be learning about the circulatory system before considering healthy lifestyles. We will be studying how humans obtain nutrition from what they eat and the impact of exercise and drugs on the body.

### PSHE

We will be learning about positive relationships and changes our bodies go through. We will be having growing up talks from the school nurses.

### Geography

We will start the term looking at fieldwork, using Ordnance survey maps and the land use in our local area. We will then look at how Hull's physical and human geography has changed over time, considering reasons why.

### French

In French, we will be developing our reading, writing, speaking and listening skills. We will be learning about classroom language and clothes using our Language Angels scheme of work through the units of 'WWII' and 'Healthy Lifestyles'.
